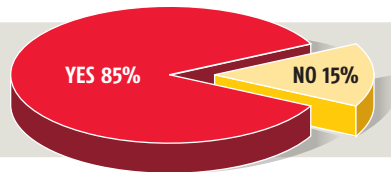


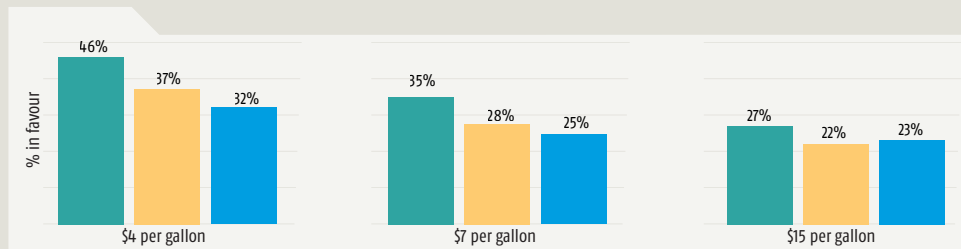
GLOBAL WARMING: WHAT THE US PUBLIC THINKS

New Scientist teamed up with Stanford University and Resources for the Future to test the popularity of six possible options for reducing US greenhouse gas emissions

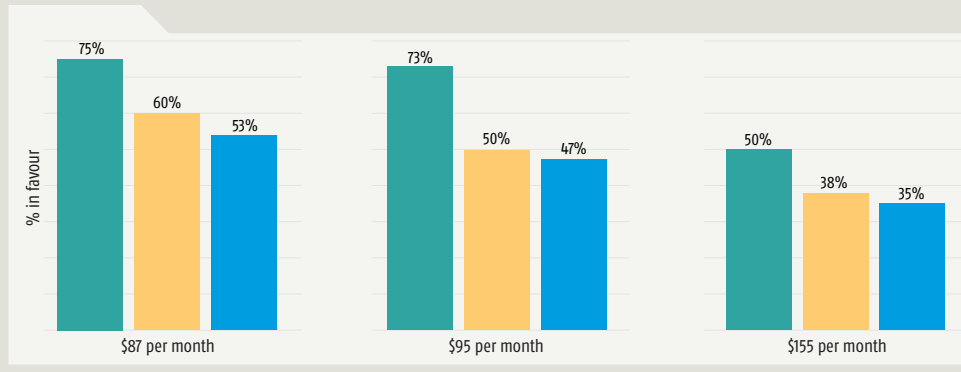
Do you believe that global warming has probably been happening?*



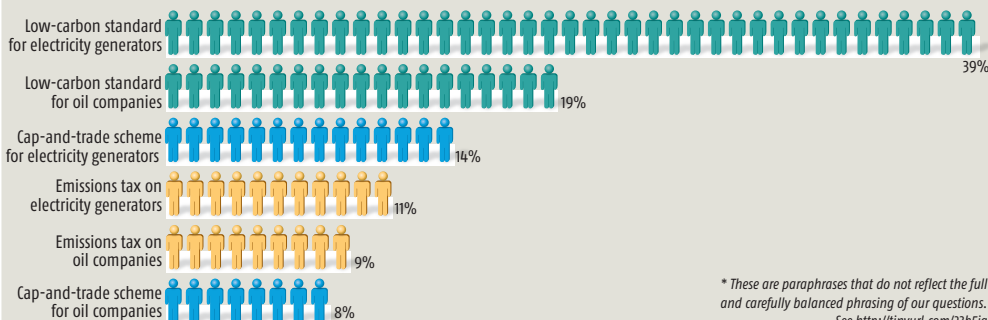
If an election were held today, would you vote in favour of this policy if it raised the cost of **vehicle fuel** to the level shown?*
